



1997

The business is founded by Joe Maynard along with his business partner and just one other employee. Working from a small unit in Halesworth, the company primarily manufactured custom colours for the cosmetics sector with a single production line. Staff headcount doubled to six by the end of the year.

2003

Organic growth results in more staff being appointed. Broadway takes on additional units on the estate to house the growing company. Space accommodated stands at 15.000 ft².

INVESTMENT:

4 x 27mm twin screw extruders and 1 x 18mm twin screw extruder.

2009

Broadway has entered new market sectors. Plans are made to move to new premises due to increasing product demand and a growing customer base.



Batch to watch for the future





2011

Broadway acquires an additional 25.000ft² premises and launches roto powder production from the existing site.

INVESTMENT:

Pallmann grinder and 75mm single screw compound line completed.

2012

Broadway's bigger customer base results in increasing demands for larger lot orders.

INVESTMENT:

5th 27mm twin screw extruder - capable of higher output than previous models.

2013

Roto powder orders increase and greater demand for larger lot masterbatch orders means more space is required.

INVESTMENT:

90,000sq ft premises in Holton, Suffolk is acquired and renovation work begins.

2014

The entire business is now under one roof at the new Holton facility - the site we still operate from today.

INVESTMENT:

Weather testing and additional QC equipment added to the growing laboratory. A second grinder is installed, increasing grinding capacity by 100%.

2015

Broadway's on-site colour matching suite is launched.

INVESTMENT:

Second 75mm single screw compound line is added to support increased demand for roto powders. Investment is made in the colour suite build.

2016

Staffing levels increase to cope with greater workload across masterbatch and roto powders divisions. A new production line is required to manufacture smaller lot sizes more efficiently.

INVESTMENT:

Second 18mm twin screw extruder added, reserved to produce smaller lot orders.

2018

Broadway continues to diversify and demand soars. Requirement to increase masterbatch & compounding capacity.

INVESTMENT:

40mm twin screw extruder installed for masterbatch and compounding services, offering double the throughput of existing machines.













2019

Additional staff taken on across technical, production, sales and purchasing departments.

INVESTMENT:

Energy efficient upgrades as well as further laboratory testing equipment.

2021

Expansion into Germany with launch of Broadway GmbH. New laboratory built to increase capacity for R&D and testing. Second 40mm twin screw extruder installed.

INVESTMENT:

New laboratory is built and new production line added.

2022

Broadway celebrates 25 years in business. The company rebrands and launches a new website. New QC and improved mixing facilities are added.

INVESTMENT:

New mixing equipment. Internal and external site upgrades including new QC area. Marketing investment including new website build.

Sustainability and innovation

When it comes to manufacturing, we understand the need to minimise our environmental impact. We signed up to Operation *Clean Sweep*[®] – an international program designed to prevent plastic materials entering the marine environment. Our Corporate Social Responsibility Team continue to review our processes with a view to making further improvements wherever possible.

Despite all the bad press plastic receives, we know lifecycle analyses prove it's often the greenest material choice. Alternatives such as glass, aluminium and paper may use more resources, more water and energy in production and more fuel in transportation. Greenwashing often sees companies eliminating plastics, but sadly replacing them with alternatives which are more harmful to the environment. We believe it's important for material choices to be based on doing good, not simply looking good in the eyes of consumers and the media. We promote the mantra of reduce, reuse and recycle.

We strive to be leaders in the field of masterbatch by exploring new ideas, technologies, and additives to enhance our product portfolio. Our products and services can help brands improve the sustainability of their plastics. Our on-site colour matching suite assists customers in their transition to PCR materials. We're also trialling an odour neutraliser additive for use in PCR, as well as offering masterbatches with PCR carrier resins.

Our expert team recently developed new NIR detectable 'piano black' masterbatches for PET and PP which are EU food contact compliant. High opacity, high gloss black plastics are a popular packaging choice in the food and drink sector. However, their recycling compatibility is restricted by high levels of carbon black pigments used in traditional black masterbatches. Broadway called upon its extensive experience in colour chemistry to overcome this barrier. We see this as a real solution for the packaging industry.

Our investments in R&D are helping us realise our aim of becoming a leading partner in our customers' product development. Our market-orientated approach means we continue to evolve our product portfolio in response to the latest demands. If you have a specific material requirement then please get in touch.
