What is a plastic compound?

If you've always manufactured plastic components using a colour or additive masterbatch, dosed into your raw polymer, then maybe you've never even considered using plastic compounds.

For those unfamiliar with compounds, a compound is the complete material you'll use in production. Essentially it's your masterbatch, dosed with polymer at your required let down rate, pre-mixed, extruded and pelletised. Any constituent elements such as colour, additives or fillers can be included in the material supplied.

As our manufacturing capacity has grown, offering custom compounds has been a natural step for us. Many of our customers benefit from using compounds for certain applications.

The material will contain all the constituents you require for your moulding. It can be fed straight into your moulding machines, no need to dose colour or side feed additives.

Why might you need a compound?

If you experience inconsistencies when colouring with masterbatch then our compounds can offer you the solution. Where customers using masterbatch have to dose and distribute this accurately throughout production, those using compounded materials move ownership of this process to their supplier. This can be particularly beneficial in situations where colour consistency is vital, where production challenges occur or where high-quality dosing equipment isn't available.

When are compounds used?

Compounds are widely used in the production of very colour critical parts, for example when moulding automotive components. They can also be advantageous when moulding lightly tinted colours, particularly for large scale applications such as point of sale displays.

Some special effects such as mottles – where the materials should not be fully blended, are also best achieved using compounds.

Compounds will offer further benefit when colouring complex mouldings or when using filled plastics such as flame retardants or engineering polymers. These types of plastic carry higher levels of other components within the base resin, therefore dispersing colour can be challenging for the moulder. This can result in visible imperfections in the final component. Such problems can cause hidden costs for moulders due to increased levels of scrap, production inefficiencies or even the need to replace inappropriate material. Purchasing a compound that has already been blended helps eliminate the risk of inaccuracies.


